Is it safe for me to visit a Museum/Attraction or join one of the activities available?	Yes, the safety of our guests and colleagues is essential to us. What can I do or visit in Amsterdam?	Many of our attractions are opening their doors again from the 1st of June: Ripley's Believe it or not, Body Worlds, Red Light Secrets, and the XtraCold Icebar, among many other venues in the city.  From that date, it is also possible to join one of our cruises to sail the beautiful canals of Amsterdam.
