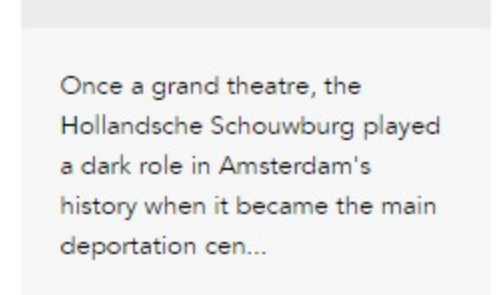
Molen Het Jonge Schaap
