Interruption of RER A between Nation and Val de Fontenay from August 9 to 18, 2023

From Wednesday August 9 to Friday August 18 2023 (included), the RER A line will be closed for works between the Nation and Val de Fontenay stations. Replacement shuttles managed by RATP will operate throughout the day, and trains will still go to the Marne-la-Vallée – Chessy station from Val de Fontenay.

If you plan to visit Disneyland Paris during this period, we advise you to plan a slight extension of your journey time or to favor another means of transportation.

To come by public transportation to Disneyland Paris, several options are available:

Bus Shuttles Château de Vincennes (Metro Line 1) <> Val de Fontenay (operated by RATP)

A replacement bus service will be set up from the Metro Line 1 Station Chateau de Vincennes to Val de Fontenay where the RER A continues its normal service towards Marnela-Vallée – Chessy station. Buses will be scheduled every 3 minutes during the peak hours. Outside these hours, the frequency will vary between 5 and 20 minutes.

RER E from Paris until Val de Fontenay

To reach the Val de Fontenay station, where the RER A continues its normal service to Marne-La-Vallée – Chessy, you can use the RER E, accessible from Paris in particular from Haussmann St Lazare.

Note that in the evening, the last RER E departing to Paris will leave Val de Fontenay around 10:30 p.m. on weekdays, and around 11 p.m. on the weekend of August 12-13.
