

- Senate Square The Cathedral an Iconic Landmark. Built during the Russian rule as a tribute to Czar Nicholas I. Open from 9:00, times vary. Free Entrance. Take a break in one of the many cozy cafés in the area and shop for Finnish Handicrafts and Souvenirs.
- Katajanokka Explore historical Katajanokka district and visit Uspenski Cathedral. Discover Helsinki from top of SkyWheel Helsinki. Experience Helsinki 's sights and attractions in the amazing multisensory show at Flying Cinema Tour Of Helsinki.
- Havis Amanda Famous female statue sculpted in 1906. Visit the Old Market Hall.
