

List of Included Museums

1) **Casino Luxembourg – Contemporary Art Forum (closed on Tuesday)**

Opening hours: Monday, Wednesday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday – 11 am to 7 pm.

Thursday from 11 am to 9 pm.

2) **Lëtzebuerg City Museum (closed on Monday)**

This museum located on the ancient Fish market, which also contains the same name, is a museum that tells the story of the city's development from its origins as a Roman settlement to its current status as a modern European capital.

Opening hours: Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday to Sunday – 10 am to 6 pm.

Thursday – 10 am to 8 pm

3) **National History Museum (closed on Monday)**

This museum is located at a stunning building that houses a large collection dedicated to archaeological artifacts, artworks and historical objects. Delve into Luxembourg's past, history of art and learn about the development from prehistoric times to the present day.

Opening hours: Wednesday to Sunday – 10 am to 6 pm.

Tuesday – 10 am to 8 pm.

4) **MUDAM Luxembourg (closed on Monday)**

The MUDAM is a contemporary art museum located in the modern and financial district of Kirchberg, in a futuristic building designed by Leo A. Meyer. This museum exhibits contemporary pieces of art.

Opening hours: Tuesday, Thursday to Sunday – 10 am to 6 pm.

Wednesday – 10 am to 9 pm.

5) **Museum Dräi Eechelen (closed on Monday)**

The Dräi Eechelen is located at a restored fortress overlooking the city. This museum focuses on Luxembourg's military history and presents exhibitions on topics such as the fortress's construction, the role of the military and facts about war on the country.

Opening hours: Tuesday, Thursday to Sunday – 10 am to 6 pm.

Wednesday – 10 am to 8 pm.

6) National Museum of History and Art (closed on Monday / open from 10 am to 6 pm)

This museum provides an immersive experience by showcasing the city's history through multimedia presentations, photographs, and interactive displays. All temporary exhibitions are not included in this ticket.

Opening hours: Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday to Sunday – 10 am to 6 pm.

Thursday – 10 am to 8 pm.

7) Villa Vauban (closed on Tuesday / 1st November / 25th December / 1st January)

This museum is focused on European Art, from the 17th to 21st century, with an emphasis on Luxembourgish artists.

Opening hours: Monday to Thursday & Saturday to Sunday – 10 am to 6 pm.

Friday – 10 am to 9 pm.
