Getting in

With your confirmed Go City reservation, make your way to Entrance A, located outside the London Eye - you can't miss it, it's a bright pink gazebo. Here, you'll have your pass scanned and validated. Keep your confirmation email handy in case you're asked to show that as well. Once your pass has been validated, you'll join the line for security before boarding your pod. Even with a confirmed timeslot, wait times from scanning to boarding can be up to 30 minutes.

Please note!

Important: if you are travelling with children aged 2 to 4, although they won't have a pass, they will still be charged admission by The London Eye. Tickets can be purchased at the self-service ticket kiosks in The London Eye main ticket office. Please allow extra time to purchase these tickets prior to your booked timeslot.

Enter via Middle Tower (opposite the Tower shop). Join the 'bought tickets' line and have your pass ready to be scanned by a member of staff. Once validated, you will pass through security/bag check before being admitted through Middle Tower.

- Pass customers do not need to book Tower of London tickets in advance but please be aware that at busy times, you may be asked to wait for the next available time slot.
- You may need to wait in line to pass through security checks.

Busy tip

The Crown Jewels are a major attraction at the Tower of London. Wait times to view them can be lengthy.

Due to conservation works, the entrance to the Tower of London may be altered. Please follow the signs on site for the correct entry point and check the [Tower of London website](#) for more details ahead of your visit.

FAQs

What is the Tower of London famous for?

The Tower of London used to be a fortress, royal palace, and prison. Nowadays, it holds the famous Crown Jewels. Every night at closing time, it has a Ceremony of the Keys, which is a 700-year-old tradition.

Is 2 hours enough for Tower of London?

It's enough time to see the highlights, like the Crown Jewels and the Yeoman Warder tour, but we'd suggest three to four hours if you'd like to see the White Tower, Bloody Tour or any ceremonies.

Facilities

- The Garden Café on the West Terrace is open serving light bites, cakes, afternoon tea and hot and cold drinks, with a view over the garden lawn towards the lake.
- Toilets and baby-care facilities are located in the garden, this is at the end of the route through the Palace. There are no toilet facilities at the start of the visitor route.

Getting in

When you arrive, please present your pass at the Ticket Office (Gate A) on Buckingham Palace Road where you will be booked in for the next available timeslot

(subject to availability) and issued with an official ticket for entry. At your entry time, go to Gate B and head through to the necessary security checks. Then enjoy your visit!

- You can enter from 12PM daily on a walk-up basis – subject to availability.
- Buckingham Palace opens to visitors each summer. Dates for summer 2026 are July 9 – September 27.
- Buckingham Palace is closed on Tuesdays and Wednesdays during September.

Wheelchair accessibility

Buckingham Palace and the Palace Garden are fully accessible. However, guests requiring step-free access must be booked on the Access Route, which is **not** available with your pass. For more information, please call [+44 \(0\)303 123 7324](tel:+44(0)3031237324).

- Please check the [Buckingham Palace website](#) for information on security and luggage restrictions.
- There is no formal dress code required to enter the Palace, but comfortable shoes are advisable as the visitor route includes a half mile walk from the left side of the garden to the exit.
- Strictly **no** photography or filming at all is permitted inside Buckingham Palace.

Getting in

Entry to the cathedral is through the West Entrance. Security/bag checks are in place before entering. Inside, your pass will be scanned and validated at the admissions desks immediately in front of you.

A step-free entrance is also available at the North Transept.

- You do not need to book but please check opening hours before visiting and take your pass with you.
- Once inside the Cathedral, access to the Dome Galleries is usually available from 9.30am to 4.15pm (10am to 4.15pm on Wednesdays). Entrance to the Golden Gallery is subject to availability due to capacity controls in operation, and there may be time restrictions in place.
- Children must be accompanied and supervised by an adult aged 18 or over in the Dome Galleries.
- No bags or items larger than airline hand baggage (45cm x 30cm x 25cm, including handles, wheels, and pockets) may be brought into the cathedral. There is no cloakroom facility.

- With your pass, you'll receive a 10% discount on purchases of £5 and more in the St Paul's shop!
- Non-flash photography for personal use inside the cathedral is welcomed outside service times. Filming, tripods, monopods, and selfie sticks are not permitted.

On the day, after the security/bag check, present your pass at the ticket desk for scanning and validation. Once your ticket has been validated, you will be issued with an entrance ticket. Please retain the ticket to gain admission to the Engine Rooms at the end of your visit.

- Shoulder bags and backpacks with maximum dimensions 45 x 35 x 20 cm are allowed. Suitcases, wheeled bags and oversized items will not be allowed in the Bridge.
- Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult.

2-Day Big Bus Hop-On Hop-Off Tour

Just show your pass when boarding or to a staff member at a Big Bus stop, and they'll scan your pass and give you a paper ticket to use each time you hop on and off.

Remember – you'll need to hang on to your paper ticket for the next day.

Disclaimer

Your Hop-On Hop-Off Bus tour ticket is valid for two consecutive calendar days. So, if your pass is scanned on a Monday, you can use your Hop-On Hop-Off ticket until the last tour on the Tuesday. It is not a 48-hour ticket.

Wheelchair accessibility

To avoid disappointment, Big Bus will need to confirm in advance whether your wheelchair can be accommodated on board. Please **contact them** in advance with information about your wheelchair, including an indication of the width and weight of the chair. Please note that mobility scooters cannot be accommodated on board buses due to size and weight.

Can I get off and rejoin the bus tour at any stop?

Yes, you can hop on and off at any designated stop throughout the day.

How long does the bus tour take to complete without hopping off?

The complete loop takes approximately two and a half hours, depending on traffic.

Are the bus tours guided?

There is no live commentary but in-seat audio guides are included as part of your experience. They are available in English, French, German, Italian, Spanish, Mandarin and Brazilian Portuguese.

What attractions and landmarks can I see on the bus tour?

You will pass by and have the opportunity to hop off at top landmarks such as the Tower of London, Buckingham Palace, and Big Ben.

Does the Big Bus tour include entrance to any of the attractions?

Generally, no, unless otherwise specified on your ticket.

The Abbey is located in the heart of the City of Westminster, just west of the similarly impressive Palace of Westminster.

How old is Westminster Abbey?

The Abbey has existed for over 1060 years, making it one of the oldest religious places of worship in England. A church was founded on the site of the Abbey in the 7th Century, and construction of the present church began in 1245, on the orders of King Henry III.

Where is the nave in Westminster Abbey?

The visually stunning nave is at the far western end of the Abbey and has become a place of homage thanks to the numerous graves and memorials of famous people that exist here.
