Empire State Building Observation Deck

Facilities

- Signage is available in nine languages – English, Spanish, French, German, Italian, Portuguese, Japanese, Korean and Mandarin.
- When it comes to dining, drinks and snacks, there are several options. Take your pick from the STATE Grill and Bar, Tacombi and Starbucks Reserve – all located **outside** of the Observation Deck experience on the ground floor of the building.
- The Empire State Building has free WiFi throughout, so you can share your experience as you explore.

Getting in

When you arrive, show your reservation confirmation, then head inside for entry.

Scan your pass at the ticket turnstile after security.

That's it, you're in, enjoy the view!

Wheelchair accessibility

The Empire State Building is fully ADA-compliant. There are accessible restrooms on the 86th Floor observation deck, along with ramps, lowered viewing walls and binoculars.

Motorized and non-motorized wheelchairs are permitted.

Please note!

- This attraction is extremely popular and gets booked up fast. If this is one of your 'must-sees', please reserve your spot as soon as possible! You can book up to 30 days in advance of your visit.
- Sunset time slots and 102nd Floor Access are available as optional upgrades.
- For the best experience, we recommend visiting 2 hours after opening time.

FAQs

What is the height of the Empire State Building?

The Empire State Building stands at 1,454 feet (443.2 meters) tall, including its antenna.

How many floors does the Empire State Building have?

The Empire State Building has a total of 103 floors above ground.

Is there an observation deck at the Empire State Building?

Yes, the Empire State Building features two observation decks, located on the 86th and 102nd floors.

How long did it take to construct the Empire State Building?

It took just 410 days, or about 14 months, to construct the Empire State Building.

When was the Empire State Building completed?

The Empire State Building was completed on April 11, 1931.

What is the best time of day to go up the Empire State Building?

The Empire State Building is great at any time of day. Head there during daylight hours to get a clear view of the surrounding landmarks or at night to see the skyline light up.

How long does it take to do Empire State Building?

Most people spend between 1-2 hours visiting the Empire State Building, including spending time at the museum and taking in the views at the observation decks.

Is the 102nd floor included with the pass?

The 102nd floor isn't included but can be added to your experience through the Go City app. Soar to the highest observation deck of the Empire State Building and take in 360-degree views of the Big Apple.

Hours of operation vary by day. Last entry is always 45 minutes prior to closing.

Facilities

- Food and drinks are not permitted but there are plenty of dining options available at Rockefeller Center, as well as a terrace cafe on one of the observation decks.

The Weather Room pairs Top of the Rock's sweeping cityscapes with locally-sourced artisanal sandwiches, mezze plates, pastries, coffee and cocktails. Enjoy a tasty beverage or sandwich while taking in New York's stunning sights.

Getting in

When you arrive for your pre-booked slot, show your booking info and enter through the glass revolving doors. Then head up the stairs, where a staff

member will scan your pass and you'll go through security to enter the experience.

That's it, you're in, enjoy the view!

Wheelchair accessibility

Top of the Rock and the Rockefeller Center Tours are fully wheelchair accessible. There are accessible restrooms at Top of The Rock. Licensed service dogs are welcome.

Visitor tips

Download the [Top of the Rock App](#) before your trip. It acts as a skyline guide and as an audio tour.

Please note!

Visit between 10AM and 2PM for the shortest wait times.

FAQs

What time of day is best for Top of the Rock?

The best time to visit Top of the Rock depends on the view you want. Early morning usually means shorter waits and cleaner photos. Sunset brings golden light and a chance to see the city change from day to night, but it also draws bigger crowds. For a calmer visit, aim for a weekday outside peak evening hours.

How long does it take to see Top of the Rock?

Most people need around 45 minutes to 1.5 hours at Top of the Rock. That gives you enough time for security, the elevator ride, several viewing levels and plenty of photos. If you're visiting at sunset or you like to take your time, allow a little longer. It's an easy attraction to slot into a half-day Midtown plan.

Are Skylift and The Beam Experience included with the pass?

These experiences aren't included but can be added on in the Go City app. Rise above Rockefeller on **Skylift**, a rotating glass platform that offers 360-degree views of NYC. Or recreate the iconic 1930s ironworkers' photo on **The Beam** and enjoy Central Park from a thrilling vantage point.

You can get to One World Observatory by taking a Sky Pod elevator from the ground floor of One World Trade Center to the 102nd floor in just 47 seconds!

What can I do at One World Observatory?

At One World Observatory, you can explore interactive exhibits that tell the story of New York City, enjoy 360-degree views from the highest observation deck in NYC, and even dine at ONE Dine restaurant for an unforgettable experience!

What is One World observatory famous for?

One World Observatory is famous for being the highest observation deck in the Western Hemisphere. It's right at the top of the One World Trade Center which is the tallest building in the United States.

The app features: **Interactive maps** with clearly marked stop locations, **detailed stop information** including photos, addresses, descriptions, and walking directions from your current location and **live service updates** with notifications about any anticipated changes, accessible via the in-app message inbox.

FAQs

What is a hop-on hop-off bus tour?

Hop-on hop-off bus tours in NYC are the most convenient and efficient way to sightsee in the city. With a designated route, you can hop on and hop off at any of the stops throughout the day, allowing you to customize your itinerary and explore the sights and attractions at your own pace.

How long does the Big Bus route take?

The Big Bus Downtown (Red) route takes about 90 minutes, while the Uptown (Blue) route takes 60-75 minutes. Happy sightseeing!

Look out for the Empire State Building, the Chrysler Building, the bright lights of Times Square, and the greenery of Central Park.

Show your valid pass at one of these locations to enter:

- **Rose Center Entrance** (81st St between Central Park West and Columbus Ave) and proceed downstairs to the Will Call window (*Insider tip: this location often has shorter lines*)
- **Gilde Center Entrance** (79th and Columbus Ave) and proceed to the ticketing desk (*Insider tip: this location often has shorter lines*)
- **Main Entrance** (79th St at Central Park West) and proceed to the ticketing desk

Wheelchair accessibility

The Natural History Museum New York is fully accessible.

Visitor tips

Plan to spend around 2 hours 30 minutes at the Museum of Natural History, but reserve an extra hour if you plan to see a special exhibition.

FAQs

Can I bring my own food to the American Museum of Natural History?

Outside food and beverages are not permitted inside the museum, but there are multiple cafes and restaurants available for dining.

Is there parking available at the American Museum of Natural History?

Yes, the Museum has a parking garage at its Rose Center for Earth and Space entrance at 81st St between Central Park West and Columbus Ave.

Getting in

Once you arrive at the Museum, proceed through a security inspection. Scan your pass at any kiosk on the left side of the lobby to receive a printed ticket. Show your printed tickets at the gallery entrance for admission.

Children ages 16 and under receive free general admission.

Busy tip

The morning is the most crowded time to visit. We suggest visiting during an alternate time.

Wheelchair accessibility

MoMA is accessible and wheelchairs are available on a first-come, first-served basis and are free of charge.

Visitor tips

- There are dining opportunities within the museum including The Modern restaurant, Café 2, and The Terrace Cafe.
- Connect to MoMA NYC's free WiFi and get access to the museum's digital map and audio guides. Charging stations are also provided throughout the Museum.
- Join artists, curators, and creative thinkers for conversations and workshops in the Crown Creativity Lab, MoMA's new participatory space on Floor 2; or visit the family-friendly Art Lab.

Please note!

- Our checkroom is currently closed. Scooters, skateboards, rolling bags, and all items over 11×17×5" [28×43×13 cm] are not permitted in the Museum. All bags will be inspected upon arrival. Please wear backpacks on the front of your chest or carry them to the side.
- Photography is permitted, but video is not.

FAQs

What is the Museum of Modern Art (MOMA)?

The Museum of Modern Art (MOMA) is one of the world's largest and most influential modern art museums, located in Midtown Manhattan in New York City. MOMA houses an impressive collection of artwork from the mid-19th century to the present day, including classics such as Monet, van Gogh and Picasso.

Where is MOMA located?

The Museum of Modern Art (MOMA) is located at 11 West 53rd Street between 5th & 6th Avenues in Midtown Manhattan.

Can I take photos inside the museum?

Yes! All visitors are allowed to take photos inside the museum except for certain restricted areas designated by staff or security guards throughout the premises – please do not hesitate to ask if you're unsure where photography is allowed or not permitted!

What else can I do while visiting MOMA?

Aside from admiring amazing artwork collections on display, visitors can also enjoy shopping at various bookstores or gift shops that are found throughout the museum or participate in various educational tours held by expert docents!

Is 3 hours enough for MoMA?

Three hours is enough time to see the main exhibits at the MoMA, while four allows you time to see the gallery's masterpieces at a relaxed pace and enjoy a lovely lunch at the Terrace cafe.

What days are best to go to MoMA?

If you're after a peaceful experience, visit MoMA on weekdays, specifically Tuesday - Thursday in the morning when the gallery opens at 10.30AM. On Friday evenings, the MoMA is open later until 8.30PM, although it can be rather busy!

Food and drink are not allowed in the museum, but there is a café in the museum pavilion.

Getting in

Show your booking confirmation date and time within the Go City app to enter the line, and then have your pass scanned to enter the building and go through security.

Arrive at your scheduled time slot for the best entry experience. There is a 15-minute grace period should you be running late.

Disclaimer

The main historical exhibit may not be suitable for children under the age of 10.

Wheelchair accessibility

A limited amount of wheelchairs are available on a first-come, first-served basis for no fee.

Please note!

- Photography **is** allowed in some areas of the museum and the memorial. In certain exhibits of the museum, photography is **not allowed**; this is clearly signed as you enter certain sections. Flash photography, tripods, selfie sticks, and video recording are **not permitted** throughout.

FAQs

How long does it take to visit the 9/11 Museum and Memorial?

Visitors typically spend about two hours exploring both indoor exhibitions and outdoor memorials. However, some visitors may choose to spend more time exploring specific areas or exhibits.

Can I bring bags into the 9/11 Museum and Memorial?

To ensure visitor safety and to respect the space, bags larger than a small purse or camera bag are not allowed inside. Visitors can check their bags at a designated cloakroom area before entering.

Can you walk around Ground Zero for free?

If you'd just like a contemplative walk around the Memorial Plaza at Ground Zero, this is free to do. You can also see the Reflecting Pools where the Twin Towers once stood and the Oculus for free.

Is there a dress code for the 9/11 Memorial?

There's no formal dress code, but visitors should think about dressing respectfully as the 9/11 Memorial and Museum is a place of remembrance. Please also remember to wear comfortable walking shoes.

The memorial is open daily: 8AM - 8PM

9/11 Museum

- For an additional cost, you can get exclusive overnight access to the ship and Space Shuttle Pavilion. You'll sleep among the aircraft, just like enlisted sailors once did.

Can visitors go aboard the Intrepid Museum's aircraft carrier?

Yes, visitors to the Intrepid Museum can go aboard the museum's historic aircraft carrier, the USS Intrepid.

Is the Intrepid Museum accessible to visitors with disabilities?

Yes, the Intrepid Museum is fully accessible to visitors with disabilities, with wheelchair ramps and elevators throughout the museum.

Can visitors bring food and drinks into the Intrepid Museum?

No, outside food and drinks are not permitted inside the Intrepid Museum. However, there are several dining options available within the museum.

How much time do you need at the Intrepid Museum?

Plan on spending two to three hours at the Intrepid Museum, so you get a chance to see the aircraft carrier, Space Shuttle pavilion, and the submarine, Growler.

What is the best time to visit Intrepid?

Try to visit the Intrepid Museum on weekday mornings at 10AM when it opens - it can get very busy from 3.30 to 5PM!

Please download the app and click on the Go City banner on the home screen to begin the redemption and reservation process. Note: Please scan and add all passes into a single reservation for your entire party.

For expedited and skip-the-line service, reservations can be made up to 7 days before your desired activity date in the [Unlimited Biking App](#).

After redeeming your pass in the app, please arrive at the store any time after opening to check in.

- All guests must bring one government-issued photo ID and a credit card to be kept on file for the security of the bikes.
- For ebike upgrades, please inquire on-site at check in for availability and rates.
- Tandems are available for two passholders to ride together subject to availability.
- As a bonus, enjoy complimentary bike drop-offs at either of Unlimited Biking's two locations (a \$5 value).
- For group reservations of 15 or more, please contact groups@unlimitedbiking.com

Don't forget to lock up your bike if you stop for a bite to eat at one of NYC's best cafes or restaurants.
