



Eiffel Tower 2nd Floor Guided Climb

Getting in

This Tour is hosted by Experience First.

Your guide will be holding an orange sign that says ExperienceFirst. Please meet them outside the Eiffel Tower and don't pass through any security checks. You will find them outside the South Security Entrance (Entrance #1) of the Eiffel Tower on Allée des Refuzniks, near the trees and the benches. Present your reservation confirmation and your pass will be scanned by the guide. Please arrive 30 minutes early for check-in.

Once you've made your booking, you'll be sent an email confirmation with meeting point instructions.

- This tour involves climbing 674 stairs.
- The tour is guided to the 2nd floor. (Please note that the summit is not included)

- **The experience takes 3 - 4 hours depending on the queues to enter the Eiffel Tower**
- Available in English only.

Disclaimer

No skip-the-line access – all guests must pass security screening and any entry queues. Queue times vary so please allow 3–4 hours in total due to possible queues and security.

If you miss the check-in time, unfortunately you cannot join your guide once they are already inside the Eiffel Tower grounds.

Wheelchair accessibility

This tour is not wheelchair accessible. If you have mobility impairments, you are encouraged to visit the Eiffel Tower on your own using the special priority entrance.

- The tour is guided to the 2nd floor. (Please note that the summit is not included)
- Reservations secure your tour time but **do not** provide skip-the-line access at security or entry.
- The Eiffel Tower has strict security protocols and entry may be refused for large bags or prohibited items (please do not bring a suitcase).
